Letter of Authority for Seniors Energy Rebate

A letter of authority is a legal document that authorises a third party to act on your behalf. Both you and the third party (**Authorised Agent**) will need to complete this letter of authority.

## Eligibility

In addition to eligibility and documentation requirements for the Senior Energy Rebate, found on the Service NSW website, you may complete a letter of authority if you are unable to attend a Service Centre and wish to authorise a third party (**Authorised Agent**), to apply on your behalf.

## **Identity requirements**

You MUST provide proof of identity of yourself and your **Authorised Agent** by supplying certified copies from the list below. Your name should be the same on both documents and must be current if they display an expiration date.
